- Bull test of 112 days(self fed)
- Bull test 112 days (hand fed, minimum 15hd)
- Heifer development program (self fed & hand fed)
- Retained Bull Development (no option for sale, 2025 calendar year bulls)

Please find attached your nomination forms for the 2025-2026 development season. The Douglas Bull & Female Development Center encourages consignors to spread the word to all producers in the area so we can make this the best test year yet. All test bulls and heifers will be eligible for sale. The data collected for Weight per day of Age (WDA) and Average Daily Gain (ADG) will no longer determine sale eligibility but will still be published in our weight reports. All

Bulls and Heifers must pass a breeding soundness evaluation (including semen, scrotal, structure, palpation and pelvic measurements) to be qualified for the sale. MBCPA charges a 15% commission to sell your animals in the annual sale. This fee applies to any animal entered in the sale regardless of sale outcome.

Once again, upon arrival, all animals will be vaccinated and de-wormed. Heifers will receive pre-breeding vaccinations prior to sale.

Rules and regulations are available upon request. Consignors are responsible for all extra costs associated with getting your animal to sale day. Ie. Pictures, videos, breeding evaluation, DNA, vet fees, etc. Feel free to contact Cam for a list of 2024-25 expenses.

As a consignor, it is required that you help out during the test season on a weigh day, picture/video days or semen test day. By helping out, it has in the past reduced the cost to consignors. We understand that some consignors either work other jobs or live a long distance away and can't always make it to help.

The fee of \$200 will be charged on your nomination form and will be credited back to your account once you have worked your day.

Cam will request help by email and will require commitment the week prior to weigh day. You must make arrangements with Cam so that there are not 6 helpers for one weigh day and only one on a different day.

Nominations are required by September 15, 2025. If unable to have nomination forms submitted by this date, please contact Cam to verify the number of bulls/heifers that are being sent. By verifying the number of bulls we are able to order feed, organize pens accordingly for delivery and have numbers available. We will accept bulls after this date, but if we have not been contacted in regards to bull numbers it makes it very difficult to plan for the upcoming test season.
